Dr. Sanders holds a PhD in government from Harvard University, is a professor of public administration at the University of Texas at San Antonio and has taught at Brown University, the University of Illinois, and Trinity University. His research has examined the character of urban politics and urban development, including the 2005 Brookings Institution study of convention centres, "Space Available." He is currently completing a book on convention centre development and politics.
